Hi, whippet buddies, it's me again - Abby - with another clever tip to add to your collection.





Ule and Connie were pleased to see that "raw meat deprived" Charlie was actually able to tie Salty "Raw Meat Schwartznegger" in one race meet, at least. We attribute this to allowing Charlie to be out in the elements (lightning storm) which must have supercharged him. We highly recommend this for other CWA members hoping to improve their whippet's performance (Disclaimer: There are no guarantees to this technique, as we have only tried this successfully once, and there is always the possibility of personal injury to both dog and owner due to lightning bolts).
