

I don't have any other games to tell you about now, but if I invent any new ones, I'll let you know. Submitted by Abby Redell.


Which aircraft carrier landing strip would you pick if you were on the airplane to land on the carrier???





The second CWA double header race meet held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, was every bit the successful event that the first one was. Mother Nature smiled on us and provided cooler temperatures than the July meet along with a brisk breeze on Saturday, which was heading towards the dogs as they ran. The track at Arthur's Acres is a little greener, a little thicker and a little drier than before. On behalf of all CWA participants, I offer our thanks to the Arthur's for all their time, money, and effort spent in developing a safe and secure track for CWA events.

Saturday's meet was dominated by Marial's Reata Saltwater. Undefeated in all four heats, "Salty" went on to win the conformation event that day under judge June Mastracola of Colacove Italian Greyhounds. "Salty" is owned by the Strauss/Arthur team. Salty may have hurried to the finish line fast, so as to pursue his romantic interest in Brandeis who studiously ignored him for the love of her life, the lure. Earning 3 ARX points that day and his ARX title as well was Marial's Palmeridge Princeton CD, FBDX, ARX. "Charlie" is owned by Connie Austin and Ule James. Congratulations on yet another title for this versatile whippet! Also earning ARX points on Saturday were Ch. Marial's Palmeridge Brandeis, 2 points, owned by Almquist/Arthur and 1 point to Swiftsure Luke's Jayson, ARM, ORC who is owned by the Lukitsch's. It was also nice to see Brandy back in fine form. High scoring puppy was Marial's Palmeridge Cornell. The Saturday night potluck cookout was a great opportunity to kick back, relax and PIG OUT! A brisk, chilly wind kicked up however and caught some folks unprepared and perhaps saved others from consuming another 1000 calories or so!

Kathi Randall browsed through June Mastracola's sighthound jewelry collection but found herself in a dilemma in deciding between two nice pins. Oh, decisions, decisions. Which one should she buy? Ule James' opinion was solicited, but Ule just couldn't get past a certain part of Kathi's anatomy and focus on the pins. While pointing at the pin, located strategically on the shirt, Ule stated, "I don't like what's below here" (Well, who asked you anyway?). Ule even tried to cover up the distraction but still couldn't render an opinion. Connie never saw a more red faced Ule and neither did we! Ule claimed it was simply sunburn (just like the mud was always Charlie's fault!). Sunday dawned several degrees warmer and minus the cooling breeze. At meet's end, it was "Salty" again on top. By our count, this is the sixth meet win for this young dog. Charlie came in second and did manage to win one heat but that was due to the foul-up of the tangled string in the lure machine, which meant the dogs had to be removed from the box. Maybe we should develop some hand signals so the box loader knows what's happening or maybe we shouldn't to allow a hand signaling demonstration at both ends, kind of like Charades. I think Claire finally won the contest. Sunday's point winners were Ch. Marial's Palmeridge Brandeis earning 3 points, her littermate Marial's Palmeridge Auburn, CD earning 2 points and owned by Larry Wittman, 1/2 point to Marial's Reata Firewater, owned by Strauss/Arthur and 1/2 point to Swiftsure Luke's Jayson, ARM, ORC. Ch. Marial's Palmeridge Brandeis or "Brandy" also becomes the CWA's first Dual Purpose Champion. This is the highest level of achievement in the CWA and it recognizes the true dual purpose whippet exhibiting both speed and beauty. Congratulations to her owners on this fine achievement. Another first was the fact that Ule remained relatively clean throughout both days meets (except for his jewelry comments). Charlie succeeded in destroying yet another muzzle to the great dismay of Ule, who had high hopes for this one, as he had reconstructed 3/4 of the Halemar muzzle. But, the 1/4 left of Halemar's part broke, the plastic front, if you can believe it.

Sunday's conformation match was judged by Jean Schroeder of Willabe Whippets. She found Marial Palmeridge Pepperdine to her liking and placed her at the top of the competition. "Pepper" was second high point puppy that day and is owned by Dean and Gail Wegner. Mighty Might (alias Cornell) was high scoring puppy.

Wittman introduced the handicapping system which would reward the most improved dogs, for that particular race meet, i.e. those dogs which had the highest difference between their score at that race and their average score in the last three meets. This was proposed as an addition to, not a replacement for, regular awards which reward the top scoring whippets. Dogs receiving ARX points that day would not be eligible for this handicap award. The nice thing about this award is that it jumps around, and any dog doing well on a particular day can win.
