Larry Wittman's new four-month-old whippet puppy Sara took Hound Group II at the puppy match Saturday night at DuQuoin

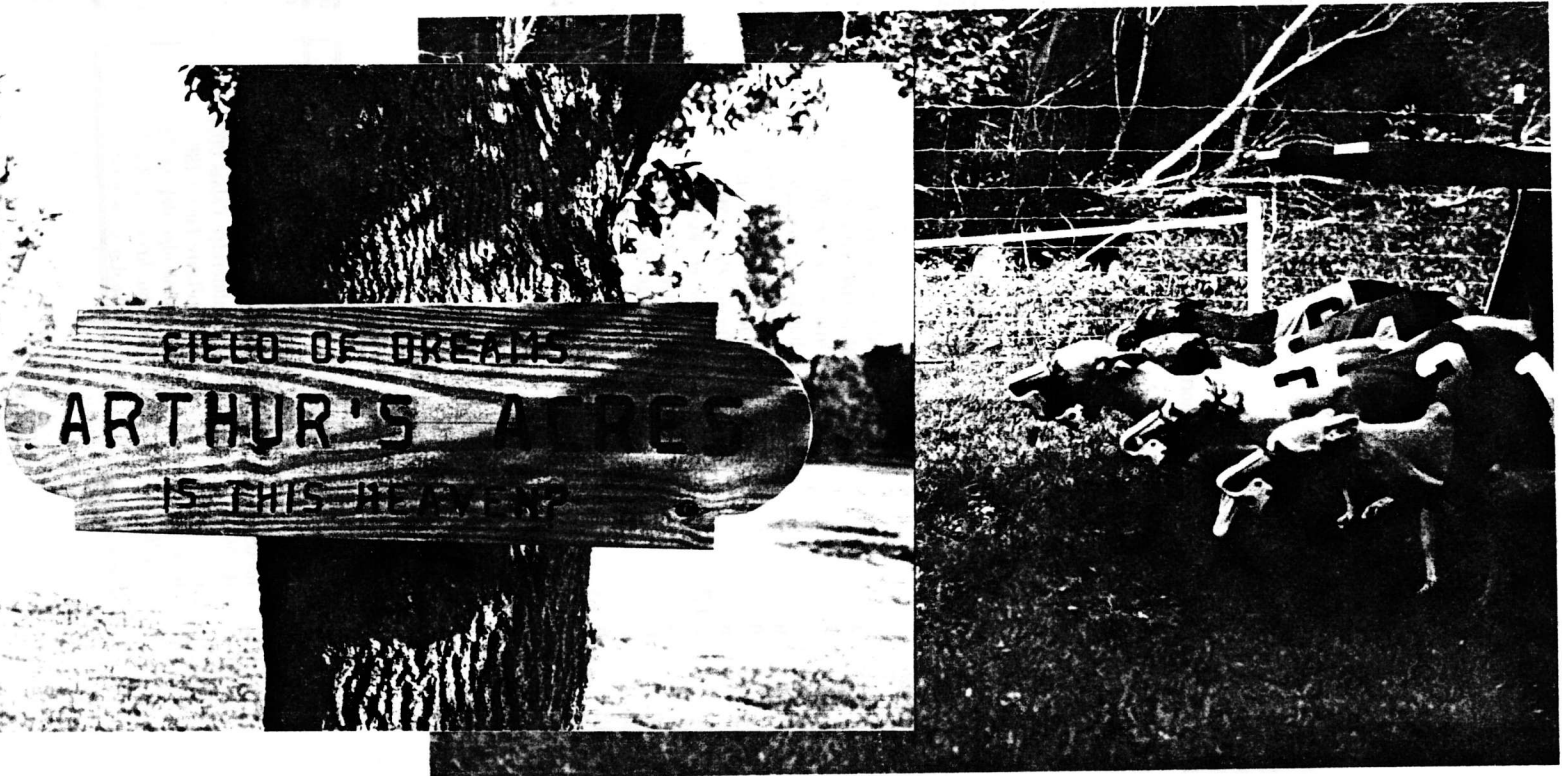
Larry Wittman's beagle Dyna took Best of Opposite Sex for two points at Crab Orchard Kennel Club show on April 26, 1992
