Talking about fast, the Cornell Animal Health Newsletter reports that pronghorn antelopes can sprint at 60 mph, second fastest to cheetahs, and can maintain a steady 40 miles per hour. Greyhounds have been recorded at speeds up to 39 miles per hour. The physiologist, S.L. Lindstedt, believes the reason for the pronghorns's speed is that they can consume three times more oxygen per unit time than other mammals of the same size. Pronghorns also have large lungs for their size, large hearts and blood richer in hemoglobin.
