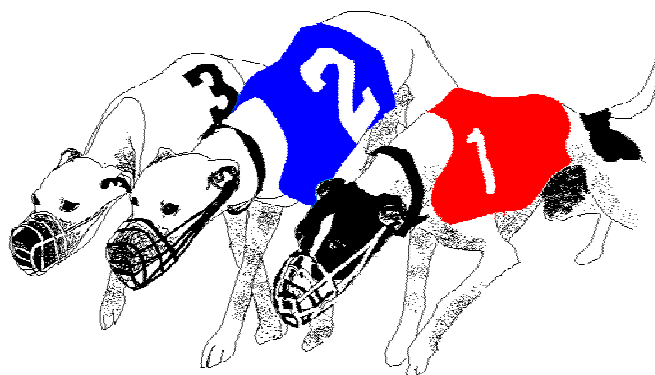

## Memorial Day Weekend Rochester IL, 2009, CURACE

Once the racing was over conformation was judged by Sandy McMillan, a Labrador Retriever aficionado and conformation person. Since Alamo Area Whippet Club began hosting CWA Racing in 2007, we have travelled out of state to WindyGlen Ranch in Oklahoma to hold our meets. The Papins have been consistently gracious hosts to us, and we appreciate deeply the assistance they have lent our up-start group of racers. As of the ASFA I.I. event, however, Windyglen Ranch has closed its proverbial doors to performance events as Don and Sally turn to other interests and leisure activities. 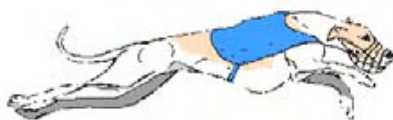
