

A Note from the Statistician/Webmaster

PLEASE SEND YOUR GRADING GUIDE UPDATES

It's time once again for everyone to take a look at the Grading Guide and let me know of new titles to be added to existing dogs, and of retired dogs that need to be moved to the Archives. In particular, I need to know about any dog finishing a conformation championship, since DPC/DPCX titles are awarded based on a conformation title.

In the interests of keeping the Guide at a manageable size, I also want to know about retired dogs that can be moved to the Archives. I did recently archive approximately 250 dogs that do not appear to have run a CWA meet within the past 3-5 years, so if you have a CWA registered dog that you have not run for several years, you may want to take a look and see where it appears. If any of the archived dogs will in fact run a complete meet this year, let me know and I will put them back in the main guide. (Dogs that are running on a part-time basis do not need to be on the full guide since their average will not change unless they run a full meet.)

If you are the proud owner/operator of a SRA or DPCX dog, you are entitled to have a free page on the CWA website. The page should have pedigree information (if your dog is listed in The Whippet Archives, a link there will suffice) and photos, along with text you would like to add.

 - D. Entry Fees

Change From:

Entry fees must accompany the completed entry blank and shall be fixed by the Affiliated Club/Group.

To:

Entry fees shall be fixed by the Affiliated Club/Group, and must be paid by the date designated by the Affiliated Club/Group or, if no date is so designated, before the start of the last day of racing.

E. Entry Blank

Change From:

A Whippet must be entered on an official CWA entry blank (see Appendix). The entry must be completed fully and provide the following information: registered name, race division (puppy, adult), race performance average plus scores at last three complete race meets, actual owners name, address, telephone number, and all titles earned by said Whippet. First time entered (FTE) should be noted in the average blank.

To:

A Whippet may be entered via email or other electronic communication at the Race Secretary's discretion. If electronic entry is permitted, the entry must include all information requested by the Race Secretary. If an entry blank (see Appendix) is to be used, the entry must be completed fully and provide the following information: registered name, race division (puppy, adult), race performance average plus scores at last three complete race

meets, actual owners name, address, telephone number, and all titles earned by said Whippet. First time entered (FTE) should be noted in the average blank.

Rule change #2

CHAPTER V (Officials)

A. Race Secretary

Change From:

The Race Secretary is responsible for the conduct of the race meet and conformation competition. The Race Secretary must request the dates from the President, receive entries and fees, appoint qualified officials, select a conformation judge and assure that accurate results of the meet are submitted to the Statistics Committee and to the Line and Lure Editor. Race-by-race results and final standings must be received by the Statistics Committee within forty-eight (48) hours; full and complete results of the meet must be received by the Line & Lure Editor, and per capita fees must be received by the Treasurer, within fourteen (14) days.

To:

The Race Secretary is responsible for the conduct of the race meet and conformation competition. The Race Secretary must request the dates from the President, receive entries and fees, appoint qualified officials, select a conformation judge and assure that accurate results of the meet are submitted to the Statistician. Race-by-race results and final standings must be received by the Statistics Committee within ninety-six (96) hours; if results are going to be later than that for any reason, the Race Secretary is responsible for contacting the Statistician as quickly as possible so that the results may be tabulated as quickly as possible. Full and complete per capita fees must be received by the Treasurer, within fourteen (14) days.

CHAPTER VI

Format of Race Meet

Change From:

1. Grading Principles. All adult Whippets shall have a Grade Classification, A, B, C, D, or FTE. Whippets shall be seeded by using the grading guide. First time entered shall be dispersed through the Grade "D" entrants as the Race Secretary deems appropriate.

To:

- 1. Grading Principles. All adult Whippets shall have a Grade Classification, A, B, C, D, or FTE. Whippets shall be seeded by using the grading guide. Whippets that are entered for the first time in the Adult Division, are designated as FTE (First Time Entered), and are classed as grade D Whippets in that first race meet, with the following exceptions:
- a) Any Whippet having a racing grade from the Whippet Racing Association (WRA), or the North American Whippet Racing Association (NAWRA), or the

National Oval Track Racing Association (NOTRA), or the Canadian Amateur Racing Association (CARA) will retain that grade when FTE in a CWA race meet. b) Any Whippet that the Race Secretary has personal knowledge of, either from having seen it race as a puppy, or in training races, may be started, with the approval of the owner, at any grade other than grade A. Decision must be based upon personal knowledge; information acquired from others may not be used. From that point on, the Whippet will earn his/her average, and therefore, grade qualification.

Rule change #4

1. Identify the specific Chapter and Paragraph of the CWA Rules for Events you propose amending.

Chapter V – Officials; B - Inspection Committee

2. State in exact words what your proposed revision, deletion or addition is and where it would fit into existing wording.

Add a new paragraph at the end: Upon completion of checking for disqualifications, each whippet must be gaited down and back in front of the inspection committee to check for soundness. Any deemed to be unsound by the inspection committee whippet shall not be allowed to compete in the race meet.

Rule change #5

1. Identify the specific Chapter and Paragraph of the CWA Rules for Events you propose amending.

Chapter VI, Format of Race Meet, C. Adult Grading System

- 2. State in exact words what your proposed revision, deletion or addition is and where it would fit into existing wording.
 - 1. Grading Principles

Delete the 5th sentence which reads: "In grading the Whippets, the Race Secretary shall group Whippets with similar averages as closely as possible."

2. Selection of Box Positions.

In the first paragraph revise the first sentence from "The first program is arranged to match Whippets of comparable speed, based upon past performances." To read: "The first program is arranged to match Whippets based on their Starting Grade." In the second paragraph add the following sentence to the end of the paragraph: "In the first program, dogs shall be selected randomly for the race they are in."

3. Rotation by Points.

Add the following paragraph at the beginning of this section: In the first program Whippets are grouped by Starting Grade (See 2. Selection of Box Positions, second paragraph). Points will be awarded per the schedule below; however, all Starting Grade A races will be scored as a High Point Race in the first program.

Rule change #6

Chapter XIV, Race Track and Equipment, D. Muzzles

2. State in exact words what your proposed revision, deletion or addition is and where it would fit into existing wording.

Insert the following sentence after the 5th sentence (which ends with "...potential for injury, are prohibited."): The use of blinders (blinkers), flaps attached to or a part of the muzzle that create a blind spot beside the dog wearing them, are prohibited.

Rule change #7:

1. Identify the specific Chapter and Paragraph of the CWA Rules for Events you propose amending.

CHAPTER XVI Titles

2. State in exact words what your proposed revision, deletion or addition is and where it would fit into existing wording.

A. Definitions

Replace in the first sentence 5 titles with 7 titles. Add in the second sentence after TRP, Performance Racer (PR) and after ARX, add National Award of Racing Excellence (NARX). These changes would reflect our current and new correct title information under this heading.

C. Delete the Title of Racing Proficiency Excellence and replace with this new title.

C. Performance Racer (PR)

This award is intended to identify and rank the overall career of the racing Whippet. This title is based on the number of accumulated race points a Whippet earns throughout his racing career. To achieve the PR a Whippet must earn fifty (50) race points. Any holder of the PR title who accumulates an additional one hundred (100) race points will earn another title and be known as a PR2. Further PR titles will be awarded after each additional one hundred (100) race points earned with the numeral being increased to reflect the number of titles earned. A whippet must complete the meet to qualify the points towards this title. This title is continued during and after other titles are accumulated, as the purpose of this title is to reflect on the merit of the racing Whippet's entire career. Total race points will be recorded on the CWA website grading guide. Certificates documenting the completion of the initial PR title will be distributed upon achieving this award. Additional certificates of PR II and above will not be automatically distributed, however they may be requested. If owners wish their Whippets' previous years' achievements to be included, they must submit documentation as proof of previous race points to the statistician for the titles earned.

Rule change #8

1. Identify the specific Chapter and Paragraph of the CWA Rules for Events you propose amending.

RULES FOR EVENTS Chapter II, Eligibility, A. 3

2. State in exact words what your proposed revision, deletion or addition is and where it would fit into existing wording.

Replace entire existing #3 with the following:

3. For the purposes of this rule, "domestic" is defined as any whippet born in the USA or Canada. "Foreign born" is defined as any whippet born outside these two countries.

Foreign born Whippets must be registered in their country of birth. The CWA Registration application must include four generations of certified pedigree including complete registration numbers (either a certified four-generation pedigree, or certified pedigrees equal to four generations, i.e., certified three-generation pedigree PLUS certified pedigrees of parents).

The foreign born whippet must have a minimum of one Show Champion (competitive Show Champion title) in the first three generations of its 4-generation pedigree. This requirement will apply to all litters born after April 1, 2007. A "competitive show championship" is defined as a champion-ship which requires defeating other dogs in competition to earn the title. See UNITED KINGDOM below for different Show Champion requirements.

To be eligible for CWA registration, Whippets from the countries below must adhere to the listed requirements:

BELGIUM: Must have a LOSH registration designation. Any other registration designation is not accepted. No dog with the RISH registration may appear in the four generations.

FRANCE: No dog with the designation TI on its registration number may appear in the four generations.

GERMANY: A three-generation certified VDH (German Kennel Club) pedigree for the submitted dog AND a three-generation certified VDH pedigree for each parent (to equal four certified generations) is required. If one or more parents are not German registered, then the requirements already defined apply to a 3-generation pedigree of the parents of the applicant dog (i.e., no RISH, TI, or equivalent dogs appearing in their three-generation pedigrees).

UNITED KINGDOM: A Whippet either imported from the United Kingdom or with a U.K. imported sire or dam must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- a. Whippet must have a show champion within 3 generations; AND/OR
- b. Whippet must have a passport from the official pedigree racing association or be eligible for a passport

If there is a foreign-born ancestor within a domestic-born Whippet's pedigree, the country of birth and original registration number must be provided. However, this information is only required for the ancestor closest to the applicant dog (e.g., for the sire but not the grandsire).

CWA Registration applications for foreign born dogs from countries other than those noted below must provide not only certified official four generations of pedigree listing registration numbers, but also a complete description of what the various numbers and designations mean for the dogs in the pedigree.

BY-Law change #1:

1. Identify the specific Article, Section and Paragraph of the CWA Constitution & By-Laws you propose amending.

ARTICLE IV Committees, Section 1 (d)

2. State in exact words what your proposed revision, deletion or addition is and where it would fit into existing wording.

CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS

ARTICLE IV Committees, Section 1 (d) Replace entire existing (d) with the following:

3. For the purposes of this rule, "domestic" is defined as any whippet born in the USA or Canada. "Foreign born" is defined as any whippet born outside these two countries.

Foreign born Whippets must be registered in their country of birth. The CWA Registration application must include four generations of certified pedigree including complete registration numbers (either a certified four-generation pedigree, or certified pedigrees equal to four generations, i.e., certified three-generation pedigree PLUS certified pedigrees of parents).

The foreign born whippet must have a minimum of one Show Champion (competitive Show Champion title) in the first three generations of its 4-generation pedigree. This requirement will apply to all litters born after April 1, 2007. A "competitive show championship" is defined as a championship which requires defeating other dogs in competition to earn the title. See UNITED KINGDOM below for different Show Champion requirements.

To be eligible for CWA registration, Whippets from the countries below must adhere to the listed requirements:

BELGIUM: Must have a LOSH registration designation. Any other registration designation is not accepted. No dog with the RISH registration may appear in the four generations.

FRANCE: No dog with the designation TI on its registration number may appear in the four generations.

GERMANY: A three-generation certified VDH (German Kennel Club) pedigree for the submitted dog AND a three-generation certified VDH pedigree for each parent (to equal four certified

generations) is required. If one or more parents are not German registered, then the requirements already defined apply to a 3-generation pedigree of the parents of the applicant dog (i.e., no RISH, TI, or equivalent dogs appearing in their three-generation pedigrees).

UNITED KINGDOM: A Whippet either imported from the United Kingdom or with a U.K. imported sire or dam must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Whippet must have a show champion within 3 generations; AND/OR
- Whippet must have a passport from the official pedigree racing association or be eligible for a passport

If there is a foreign-born ancestor within a domestic-born Whippet's pedigree, the country of birth and original registration number must be provided. However, this information is only required for the ancestor closest to the applicant dog (e.g., for the sire but not the grandsire).


CWA Registration applications for foreign born dogs from countries other than those noted below must provide not only certified official four generations of pedigree listing registration numbers, but also a complete description of what the various numbers and designations mean for the dogs in the pedigree.
