

Ft. We are doing our best to keep CWA racing going in this area, and even some of the smaller WRA clubs are struggling to make entry, so we were actually quite pleased to have a number of good dogs and a lot of willing workers turn out so that we could have an enjoyable weekend. While nobody got to take a program off, we had enough people to run our meet and we had what most longtime participants agreed was some of the closest and best racing at all levels we had seen in this area for a number of years. If you did not come, you really missed seeing some great competition, both in the racing and the match shows.

Saturday, we had 18 adult and 1 puppy starter. There were several returning ARX point favorites, including Kohl, Latch, Raffles, and Trick--all of whom have taken ARX points at past MAWRA meets, and two "wild cards" in our FTE's Tattoo and Augie Dog. Augie delighted owners Leila, Kristen, and Karen by running lights out to finish 2nd in the meet and take the top set of ARX points. The bottom ARX point was in contention until the very last program, where Voges proved a spoiler in the cofeature, blocking out dogs who would have taken the point had they won, while Kohl put up a good enough finish in the final High Point to capture the bottom ARX point. Our other FTE for the day, Tattoo, delighted owner Linda Solano with a clean program, a solid B score, and winning the DPC leg in the match, judged by conformation Whippet handler/owner/breeder Helen Dalton. The rest of the match placements went to Augie, perennial CWA Match Queen Maura, and Trick, rounding out a strong day for the George Evans entry of Ripley and Trick.



The NARX points were very much up for grabs all day, with close finishes between Faye-Faye, Paige, and Augie, who took turns beating each other, but in the end, it was Faye-Faye on top, winning the meet and three nationals for delighted owner Steve Damron. High Score Puppy was the 9 month old "Bomber"--Surrey Hill's U Sunk My Battleship!

After the meet, we started some dogs and proofed a few others.

Sunday, Bomber moved up to adult in order to assure a 20 dog meet and the higher sets of points, and we had exceptional racing again with a few additions from the day before. He selected for his winner the ably-presented Vendome (thank you, Diane Motzkus!), followed by puppy/FTE Bomber (DPC leg), Latch, and Tattoo. As always our substitute handlers help us to get most of our finishers into the match at MAWRA events, which is great for our judges and great for our level of competition. We had NO scratches on Sunday!



There were several dogs in this area we have box-broken which were not able to attend for various reasons, but we hope to get them in July. We definitely need a little more participation from outside the area to get to that magic number of 30, but in the meantime, we had a great weekend--it was a lot of fun and the racing was close and very competitive.

Thanks to lure operators Steve Damron and Kristen Fredericks, Box Operators Linda Solano and Carl Morgan, and members such as Diane Motzkus who came both days with no entry--that is the hall-mark of a dedicated member, trophy chair Terri DeLuca, and as always our own members and guests who work every program in whatever capacity they can.

We also had 6 MAWRA Match Racers on Saturday and 2 Match Racers on Sunday. Good practice and conditioning was had by all and I think it was a good thing to add to our overall programme.

Saturday

On Friday when the Race Secretary called up to Myer's Event Center to see about delivering our race-boxes to the field for the next day's meet, the event coordinator said, "We have to change your club name.." Curious about his unexpected dislike for our name, the RS asked, "Why, Mark? What's wrong with Alamo Area?" The week before, the rain was supposed to stop. The forecasters said, clear and warm into hot with no precipitation. Did this happen? No. Come Wednesday before the race meet, the grounds are soaked, with standing water at the finish line, the puppy line and in the conformation ring. Alas, the race meet had to be cancelled and emails were sent out to everyone. Fred Luehrs called and was very disappointed. Off-handed, Ule James said: "wouldn't it be a lark if the Arthurs allowed us to have it at their place?" Fred: "I'll call!" The Arthur's were very happy to have CURace hold their race meet at Arthur's Acres. Thank you to all that helped make this happen on such short notice. Thank you Mary Beth Arthur for obtaining two good conformation judges for CURace.

Saturday

The day was clear, and dry. Looked like it was going to warm up to about 85 degrees F. Unlike the fields in Rochester IL, the soil beneath the grass here in Milwaukee, WI was starting to crack from dryness.

Measuring went on without a hitch. Doug set up cones for handlers to walk out there dogs between. Some of the agility dogs wanted to weave. Fred thought they should be farther apart. The revised rules require that dogs verify that they are not lame. Fred Luehrs (wickets) Ule James (teeth) and Janet Siehndel (butts – lucky her) were the measuring committee along with Doug Arthur (timer). Jenn Smith figured she didn't need to worry about Devon measuring in and used food to stand him. He liked the food – so much so that he measured out the first time. Mary Beth measured Devon in easily on his second try.

We had twenty-four dogs at the start. Ule James was the box guy and foul judge. Connie Austin ran the lure. Dean Wegner was mid-track foul judge. Krista Siehndel was the finish foul judge. Lisa Ochoa coordinated the line judges as well as line judged herself. At the first race of the day, Connie was reminded that she was the lure operator: Doug Arthur asked: "who's running the lure?" Ule had all the dogs loaded and was teasing them. Connie, chatting with the line judges realized she was it and jumped up surprised that Ule was ready. Ule didn't even notice.



Competition was fierce for the ARX points. There were two first-time-entered dogs, Rafa and Tanner, as well as Jamie and Indie vying for the points. Both Rafa and Tanner were hot on the heels of Charlotte. During the third program Naughty, coming back from injuries in her youth, looked like she would maintain a close second to Charlotte during the meet. Much to everyone's chagrin, Naughty, after a superb break, out in front, had Charlotte steaming full bore up on the six-side, with a nasty grin through her muzzle, Naughty turned her head and bopped Charlotte. Twice.

Clearly, Naughty was not pleased being passed by Charlotte. Nothing escaped the ever vigilant foul judges, Dean Wegner and Krista Siehndel and Naughty was disqualified (at that distance, all Ule saw was whippet butts). Meanwhile, Rafa, in the two jacket, cruised up smoothly to second, by-passing Naughty's shenanigans. Craig Jefferds (Tanner's owner) took a great video of the incident and has

put it online (http://blip.tv/file/3704194). At the last program, the ARX point seekers were tense: Rafa, Tanner, and Jamie in the high point and Indie in the co-feature. Rafa smoked up to Charlotte with Tanner a close third, putting Jamie and Indie just out the points! Charlotte took the day undefeated (watch out – Rafa and Tanner are right behind). ARX points went to Rafa and Tanner. NARX points went to Charlotte and Rafa.

The conformation judge was by Marie Jackson. Marie had a very large entry: sixteen! She was very nice to let us handlers relax under the EZ-Ups while she inspected the hounds. Marie made cuts among the dogs, then the bitches. Her final selection was Pibb, Sawyer, Slate and Sly. Sawyer got the credit for the win. Conformation prizes were Premier martingale collars. Marie got a basket full of dog stuff as a judge's gift.



EAT TIME NOW! The food was absolutely terrific! Lisa Ochoa and Pat Reynolds (now spouses) smoked a turkey – yummy. In addition, there were Siehndel beans, Austin cheesy potatoes and hamburger soup. Great salads: toss salad with grapes and strawberries, lentil salad, ricotta salad, mandarin orange salad (i.e. orange fluff). There were more deserts and additional salads too.

During dinner CURace gave out prizes. The entries for Saturday's meet required that entrants pay a small \$3 entry plus bring a wrapped gift at around \$10. If you did not bring a gift, you couldn't get one. The rules were: you can either pick a gift or take someone else's gift - steal. If you got your gift taken, you could take someone else's or pick from the wrapped pile. Not many people stole.

Connie, Ule and Debra Borton stayed at the La Quinta on Lover's Lane, near the race site. Unbeknownst to them it was High School graduation night. Graduating students rented several rooms and partied all night! The hotel staff (of one) was unable to get them quiet until 0200. Needless to say, we and many others filed complaints! Calling the manager on the Tuesday after, found out that the hotel will be changing their operating procedures regarding security. Usually, this hotel is great, although grassy areas to walk dogs are not as much as we like (is it ever?). We have stayed here several weekends without any trouble. Luckily, graduations only happen once a year!

Sunday

Measuring went well. The committee consisted of Peggy Berg (butts), Ule James (wicket) and Lisa Ochoa (teeth), Doug Arthur timed. The dogs (and handlers) walked very nicely down the widened walkway between the cones. Some of the people that came Saturday did not attend Sunday, so we were down to just twenty dogs.

The weather was the same as the day before only less wind (more bugs) and more heat (more sweat). Ule ran the box and was foul, Connie the lure, Dean was foul (again) and Lisa rallied line judges and the finish foul judge. After the first program we lost four old-timers (they love to run, but can't or shouldn't run all four programs). Regretfully, four more were scratched during the race meet. The ground was very hard and dry. I am sure the heat and ground pounded on some of the dogs. Rafa was on Charlottes heels all day. The last program, Rafa had a super break. Charlotte, stream train she is, just couldn't catch him at the finish. Much like Saturday, Rafa and Tanner got the ARX points (Jamie and Indie out of luck again!). Charlotte and Rafa got the NARX points. Even without a perfect score, Charlotte took first in the meet.

Conformation was judged by Ralph Jackson. He commented that all the dogs looked really nice and that it's a challenge to judge them. Out of the ten dogs, Ralph picked Sly, Winston, Tanner then Indie. Winston got credit for the win. Ralph got a big basket full of dog stuff as a judge's gift. Prizes were unwrapped and provided by donations and the host club. Handlers selected what they wanted as their dogs were called. Dogs were given awards by their grade placement: top A, top B, etc. Conformation winners got to pick first.




