

t wasn't QUITE March, but MAWRA's February meet went in like a lion and out like a lamb. Kristen and Shelton woke up on Friday morning to 85 degree weather, went out quickly to the field and set up all that they could in anticipation of a major storm system with high winds due to blow in later that day. Such was the severity of the expected weather that the savvy port-a-pot guy put it at the edge of the woods and tied it to the trees, lest it blow over during the night which would make for a less than optimal port-a-pot experience.

We were pleased to welcome entries from Massachusetts, Illinois, and Minnesota to our meet, along with those from our club region. Our club can now regularly come up with around 30 dogs



from our region alone, and if we get outside support, a 40 dog meet is definitely within our sights at many of our events, so keep us in mind if you are looking for substantial points! [/plug]

While the heavy rains that greeted most of our travelers did slack off and move out over the course of Friday evening, many of us had a choppy ferry ride over from Williamsburg to the field, and we all donned our scarves and hats and coats for what promised to be a chilly and blustery Saturday. The wind introduced a few challenges, especially with regard to keeping the lure from being blown around. The dogs ran into a strong crosswind and there was a little more swinging around as a result of the dogs reacting to side-to-side motion of the lure, but other-



wise, we had a really fine day of racing.

Four match racers, two puppy racers, and 34 adult entries were on the board at the start of the meet. At the end of the day, we had only two scratches, and one DQ. The DQed dog was given practice opportunities the next day as well as one of the scratched dogs, who just appeared to be a little unfocused. One of the match racers was also busted back to practice runs, and these three dogs all made great improvements Sunday and I expect to see at least two of them racing in competition later this year without incident.

Saturday was a special day for two of the dogs in particular...both of whom had come back from injuries. Ripley had a truly horrifying reaction to a venomous bite last year and had to go through a series of skin grafts. Ripley is already an ARX approaching veteran status, and for him, it was a great victory to be able to race well and





put up a Grade C score each day. The other dog coming back from injury was Cruz. Cruz has needed 1.5 ARX points, but we were beginning to fear with all the fast young prospects that will be entering adult competition this year that he may have missed his chance. He was going to need to race the meet of his life to finish...

Puppy racing was dominated by Lucy, the first of Carl Morgan's litter of Paige x Bonzer puppies to debut in competition. Lucy broke well and ran straight and true, defeating Spree by several lengths in each race. Spree's break and focus improved with each race and on the last race, she showed encouraging speed, but it was all Lucy on Saturday. While she still looks and acts very much the puppy off the track, Lucy's focus and determination racing are mature well beyond her barely 10 months of age.



Saturday's meet was won by the Hearley's Kazi, who ran undefeated on the day, for 5 NARX. Ule James' Ziggy worked the board like a maestro and managed to nip in for second and 3 NARX points with a strong performance in the fourth program.

Last November, we saw a new MAWRA star on the rise, with Rachel, owned by Ken and Lori Stebritz, blistering her way to a Grade A finish and 6 ARX points. No fluke, that, as she raced even better with a few more months of maturity under her belt—and finished 3rd in the meet for 5 ARX and 1 NARX. But the even bigger news was the aforementioned Cruz—who ran the first A score he has put up in almost two years, and



finished his ARX with 3 ARX points! You could have heard Terri's war whoop on the other side of the James River.

The final ARX point went to a new racer, Rene, who in only his second meet won his first ARX point. Rene has been doing a lot of good lure coursing since turning a year old and this young son of Butters and Joplin looks promising in racing as well.

Our turtle prize, a beautiful necklace donated by Leila Anichini, was won by the delighted Erin McNeil and her dog, Scarlett. Scarlett really did not much care for racing in that headwind and at times, it looked like it was about to blow her back down the track towards the boxes, but she

crossed the finish line every time!

Lunch was a delicious choice of Brunswick stew (a local favorite) or vegetable chili with sides. It was the perfect choice for a cold and blustery day.

Our match was judged by Yvette Ferguson—who intends to go for her judging license in Whippets. It was a difficult day for evaluation as the weather was cold and still quite windy, making toplines high for some of the 17 entrants. You never saw such a curvaceous entry! She found her lineup in Spree, Rene, Tang, and Lucy. What a great day for Lucy! Puppy winner and then to place over so many lovely dogs in the match! Brian and Fran should be having a lot of fun with her.



After the meet, we had some more practice and then convened at the Surry, VA Italian joint, one of only two restaurants in the area. Surry has a population of just 200 people, so our group alone (20?) had the town and the restaurant bursting at the seams to accommodate us. Service was slow but pleasant and cheap bottles of Fat Bastard Merlot kept everyone's windburned faces glowing at the tables.

The next day was MUCH nicer and warmed throughout the day. The puppy races were the best I can recall ever seeing at a MAWRA event.



Overnight, Spree stewed about her defeats, and came in with fire in her eye and the determination not to be left at the box. So, we saw three excellent box breaks and incredible side-by-side clean racing straight down the middle of the track by two very determined girls who both wanted to win. Spree barely edged Lucy three times to be high score puppy on Sunday... promising a lot of exciting racing to come for both.

Thirty five adult starters returned for Sunday. Without the crosswind, little Rachel wasn't being blown around quite so much and she showed she had something to say to the big brindle boys....giving Kazi and Beau close races and finally beating Kazi in the final High Point. Rachel tied Beau a couple of times, too. So, while Kazi once again won the meet, Rachel was 2nd for 3 NARX, and 5 ARX to finish her ARX title





in three meets. That's a rare achievement in CWA, not just because it is hard to win top points three times in a row, but also because it is hard to find meets which offer 5 or more ARX points for that finish three times in a row, and we are all delighted (and the ARX point hopefuls below her on the board are REALLY delighted) by her speedy finish. Lori and Ken have had some tough times and everyone celebrated their success. Our MAWRA club top racer, Beau, nipped in for the final 1 NARX finishing 3rd in the meet.

The LaQuest home cooking continued with the next set of ARX points—Rachel's kennelmate Garcia ran MUCH stronger on Sunday and earned the 3 ARX. Garcia is up to 11 points now and hopefully will finish his title sometime in 2012. The final ARX point was very much in doubt until the fourth program. There were three dogs tied which would split the 1 ARX if



the dogs who were already ARX played spoiler in the co-feature... Brando, Rene, and Monkey. Everything depended on the outcome of that race... Bacon, Cruz, and Ace were ARX dogs already, but if Tang or Aria could pull into a third or a second, they would end up in the ARX point picture. Aria and Tang had both raced exceptionally well all day, but they had a tough job ahead.

Bacon and Ace slammed the door on 1st and 2nd, but it was TANG, edging out her kennelmate Cruz (a finish that nobody expected) for 3rd. It would not surprise me if Tang and Cruise discussed the situation on the way to the box and Cruz agreed to give way to his kennelmate with the promise of some future payoff. Dream on, Cruz. You'd do better to suck up to Monkey, who now hates you for dashing the .33 ARX cup



from her lips.

Sunday's lunch was the popular deli sandwich bar. Kristen brings the best Pumpernickle Rye you will find outside of New York.

Matt Bowman became very ill overnight at the hotel, and was assisted throughout the day by Ule and Steve Damron. With a few more hours, he began to feel better and was able to make the drive home safely. It may have been food poisoning or it may have been a stomach flu bug going around... as our judge for the day e-mailed Kristen to tell her he had also woken up too ill with a bad stomach flu to come and judge. So, we were forced to look to our attendees for a

replacement. Who better than the President of CWA to rescue us from our dilemma? Ule James stepped up to the plate and did an excellent job, finding his winning lineup in Tang, Spree, Brando, and Peacock. Thanks, Ule, we really appreciate you coming through so that none of our newer people had to give up showing their own dogs.

Despite experienced line judges, we had a lot of ties, some of which I believe could only have been resolved by a camera at the finish line. A three-way tie for first is quite unusual, but we had one. I believe this is only the second three way tie for first in the history of our club. In any event, that just shows how well-matched many of our dogs are at this time.

Over the last few months, we have been discussing as members things we can do to make our meets more efficient and better-organized, both during the event and leading up to and following it, and I feel the results of those discussions really paid off.





Although all of our attendees worked very hard and were fantastic all weekend, special recognition goes to Kristen and Shelton for all their work on the field and organizing lunches, and Kristen for lure operation and Shelton for the box. Alena Tune, co-secretary, did a great job with the board both days. Terri Deluca continues to bring a fine array of trophies, and our Treasurer, Pat, was able to field test her new accounting system and the collection of fees went the best it ever has from a standpoint of keeping track of the expenses and income. Ule and Mark photographed the meet and I think people will enjoy the photos and want to have some of them for souvenirs of the weekend.

Match racing (won both days by Steve Damron's brindle speedster, Dilana) continues to be a good place for dogs to gain experience, be evaluated under racing conditions, or get needed conditioning if they can't be entered in CWA.

Thanks again to everyone—I had fun and am very proud of MAWRA's members and guests for helping to pull off such a fantastic weekend of racing and showing, and BIG thanks to Lori and Ken for the use of "LaQuest Whippet Heaven"!

he MAWRA members were pleased to welcome a large group of Whippet folks to our April Meets in Nottingham, PA. Our out-of-the-area guests were very complimentary of the beauty of the park, the surroundings, the charming local hotel, and our little towns of Nottingham and Oxford here on the far Southeast corner of world famous Pennsylvania Dutch Country. A few Amish buggies obligingly drove by while we were racing, to add to the local color.

As I looked at the list of pre-entries, I realized that while the top four or five places on the board were going to be pretty predictable, the ARX point picture was going to be very interesting indeed. Add to that the fact that we offer twin 175's at Nottingham and I knew that some dogs were going to earn their first ARX point or points this weekend, and in fact, that proved to be true for four of the five racers who ended up in the points.

The weatherman had been threatening us with a rainy Saturday for most of the week, but on Friday morning, the forecast shifted for chilly, overcast, but no rain until the evening. This proved to be accurate and although the weather was a bit nippy (made less so by Chuck and Jean's delicious lentil stew), the rain did hold off until we were all ready to pack up and leave for dinner.

32 Adult starters showed up to try their luck at the 175 yard distance. Kazi, Joey, and Beau were the top three finishers in that order. Delighted owner Jan Liscombe announced that Joey finished his NARX with the three points he earned that day. Below the three A dogs, there was a logjam of B and C dogs who had already earned their ARX's, including Bacon, Bomber, Cruz, and most of the Licketysplits.

The delighted winner of the top points was Linda Solano, with her Gus daughter, Tattoo. Linda



has worked very hard with her to put her into shape, and her work paid off as Tattoo ran her most competitive races yet. Having earned her bench championship last year, she can now look forward to going for the DPCX.

Rocketing out of the middle of the pack with an exceptionally strong fourth program race was Annie Andrews' Ringo. Ringo has been steadily improving and he seemed to love the distance and the track. We were all very happy for Ringo—her first ARX point winner! And finally, with a win in his fourth program race, Jill Hopfenbeck's Brando—a dog who has threatened for the bottom set in the past—finally broke through and snagged 1 ARX, with his final score of 10. Looking at the board, a lot of unfinished dogs held their fate in their paws in the fourth program (always fun for us board swamis to speculate on), and these three were the ones who made the most of their opportunity and rose to claim the points.

Amazingly, not ONE SINGLE DOG scratched! All 32 starters completed the meet.

The puppy races were hotly contested between littermates brought by Carl Morgan. Bose and Benjamin split the first two, then Bose won the "rubber match". Little 9 month old Twee broke

well and fought gamely, but did not have the speed to threaten the Bonzer/Paige puppies. Still, I was very happy with her effort.

Nothing like having a cheerful judge whose dog has had an excellent day—Jill Hopfenbeck judged the match and in a large entry including six supplementals, found her winning lineup in Spree, Ace, Bomber, and Joey.

When people are out in chilly air all day, they work up a good appetite—MAWRA satisfied everyone with a nice array of breakfast items and coffee for breakfast, an excellent potluck for lunch, and then those who wished to eat out all adjourned to La Sicilia, a local casual Italian joint, for big plates of pasta and calzones. Wine and beer were passed around and a good time was had by all.



The rain passed through on Saturday night while we all slept, and Sunday, we awoke to a COM-PLETELY different day. Bright sunshine and robin's egg blue skies were on tap for us, along with warmer temperatures. We lost Bacon, Cruz, and Terri to a family engagement. Tailor and Bose were sore and could not run, but we still managed to get to 30 dogs with the addition of Moto, coming back from an injury. Moto ran well in his first two programs, then scratched. The top three were unchanged from the day before—Kazi, Joey, and Beau for the NARX points.

I scratched Augie, because he was being a PITA to walk to the box, and another dog was also scratched, so there were 27 finishers.

The board was very interesting after the third program. While Tattoo, having raced even better on Sunday and now firmly ensconced in the High Point, could NOT be denied the top set of ARX, and the other five dogs in the High Point were finished, the situation in the co- and semifeatures was very far from clear. I looked at the co-feature and realized that all five dogs in that feature were not ARX'ed and further, that they had been racing extremely close to each other all weekend. I therefore requested six line judges for that race in the hopes that close finishes might be more easily resolved.

Didn't help! The finishes were still too close! Kohl and his son, Churchill, tied for first, giving each of them a score of 12. Elsa and Brando tied for third, and this kept Elsa in particular from joining the point picture. Prior to that, just turned one year old Crime Spree had her best race of the weekend to win the semi-feature and bag a 12 score as well. So, Spree, Kohl, and Churchill all won 1.33 ARX. Kohl had ARX points from three and a half years ago, but after some fairly serious injuries, he has not again been a point contender until today. Good job getting him back in shape and able to run sound again! And Churchill—what a promising young racer he has turned out to be! Big smile on the face of Pat Spinazzola.

Puppy racing was between Benjamin and Twee... and won by the faster and older Benjamin. I think Bose and Benjamin are ready to make their adult debuts soon. They are so easy to box and so quiet in the box that I was really wondering if Bonzer could be their daddy, until I heard Benjamin give tongue when the Amish buggies went by, and it was Bonzer's bloodcurdling, ear-splitting scream to be sure! No need for DNA.

We were pleased to welcome back as our match judge Cynthia Schmidt, a founding member of MAWRA who has been obliged to scale back her Whippet activities in recent years. Last time we had her judge, it was a miserable, cold, rainy day with a small entry, so I was very happy to see her get a ring full of support this time from all the grades. Cynthia found her winning lineup in Brando, Spree, Tattoo, and Ace. Ace was the recipient of two meet match DPC legs on the weekend! Cynthia was very complimentary of the quality and conditioning of her entry.

I cannot leave off our heated turtle competitions. MAWRA is known for having very slow but enthusiastic turtles... a tradition that started with Willow and Nastar and has continued to this day. We had quite a lot of depth at the bottom of the board, and the true turtle each day turned out to be Ronni, who broke well and tried very hard but at nine years old, she was not able to finish in front of another dog. Peaches was the mathematical turtle on Sunday by virtue of having run a zero score, but she did beat both Ronni and Josephine and therefore, she got a prize, but was not crowned the Supreme Turtle of the weekend. I believe Erin McNeil was actually dismayed that her usual contender, Scarlett, put up four points on Sunday, earning "most improved racer" award from the meet secretary. This will play havoc with future plans to win the turtle prizes. Slow down, Scarlett....you're breaking your mother's heart with your awesome box break and improving speed!


