

Parking:

Will be next to track so you can park at one end or the other or right in the middle.

General Info:

The property is not fenced, however we live in the country, 3 sides of the track are surrounded by either brush or a large creek. Roadside of property is protected by fencing.

Be sure to protect yourself and dogs from fleas and ticks. The track is shaded until about 11am. Bring your own shade, water, chairs.

All dogs are required to wear muzzles and racing jackets

All persons must clean up after their hounds. A penalty of \$5 will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the race in progress.

Workers:

All available to help foul judge and line judge should do so. It takes many bodies to make a race run successfully and we will need help boxing dogs, catching dogs and at the line. So please be prepared to work.

Directions:

From I-44 southbound (exit # 289) - take the Vinita exit, follow hwy 60 into town of Vinita, at 2nd stoplight turn right (north). Go to 1st stoplight and turn left (west) (this is Hope rd & county road 250), follow this road approx. 3-4 miles until road curves right (north) Do NOT take the curve Go Straight approx 1 mile, track is on north side of road. Approx 1 mile of gravel road this direction.

From I-44 northbound (exit # 283)— take the Big Cabin exit, go north on hwy 69 to hwy 60, then go left (west) on hwy 60 toward Nowata, go to county road 4340 marker signs there that say Tempson Chapel and Robson Ranch. Turn right (north) on county rd 4340 and go 1 mile, turn right (east) on county road 250 go two miles to track site. Track is on north side of road. 3 miles of gravel road this direction.

Site Camping: Dry camping is allowed at track site, there is no running water or electricity, so if camping come prepared for that. If water is needed, the house is close enough to get more water.



lamo Area Whippet Club has been unable to host CWA Racing in Texas for over a year. Whether in need of more workers, dogs or rain, we have struggled to bring our desires to fruition. This weekend put an end to a long drought, then, in more than one sense.

Our pre-entries for Saturday's meet totaled 18 and, expecting to have help from LGRA workers, we thought we were all set to begin a "routine" meet by the scheduled start time. Come inspection hour, however, we discovered ourselves short ten entries and had to drop back to form a substitute strategy. Thank goodness, "Whippet Delivery" was available in the way of club member Susan Jensen who graciously drove on demand to the field with two more Whippets to close the gap and save the meet. She was as speedy as any Domino's delivery boy eager for a tip, but just the same, we got off to a late start.

Morning temperatures were tolerable around 80-82 degrees, and a constant wind kept any truly threatening discomfort on the move. Our first two races of program 1 were filled with FTEs, and the uncertainty of these newcomers' performances made for an exciting set of runs.

Early on, the dogs began sorting themselves into appropriate speed grades and gave everyone the pleasurable show with unanimous intensity. Because the experienced A dogs present had not been able to run for over a year, we had no High Point Race in the first Program, but our B speedsters still ran like the A racers they are.

Our second program followed nearly a dozen LGRA races, and by 11:30a, the heat of the day was beginning to insist on our acknowledgment. Dropping to just two races, though, we were able to finish by 12:15p to rest in the shade and reflect on the emerging head-to-head between Gooey and Sullivan, the lead dogs after two programs.

An incredible phenomenon – though scientifically predictable I guess – happened while we were running the early races of the day. Although the ground on the field was in fair condition at inspection, the drying heat and pounding feet between 8:00a and 1:00p encouraged the small cracks in the clay-dirt to expand, to widen and to pose unsafe conditions. The Whippet entrants voted at this point to run only three programs because of rising heat and footing concerns. Eager to conclude before temperatures reached a full 96 degrees, we headed to the boxes for the last time.

The high point race was filled to the brim with an even number of FTEs and experienced dogs. They left the boxes in a burst, and pulling to the front again were Sullivan and Gooey. The LGRA folks serving as line judges anxiously awaited the on-coming pack of flying feet and panting

tongues. Down the painted line of the finish, the dogs drove hard and stretched strong. In the end, Sullivan was able to find just the inches he needed to finish with Gooey at his flank. All enjoyed the performances not only by the ARX point winners, but all the hounds new and old to the sport.

In conformation, AAWC was pleased to have long-time Sighthound enthusiast and lure coursing supporter Michael Ferris judge the dogs. His fresh set of eyes found FTE Aine most favorable on this day, commenting that her shoulders were "well set with no waste". Also placing under his eye were Sealey, Sullivan and Gooey.

Better prepared to face the heat and the change in entries, AAWC started early on Sunday with temperatures already in the mid-80s. No official FTEs, now, the first program began with four races with the B grade racers making a full box. Some C and D racers found themselves in the second program high point, making owners excited and anxious both. The scenario reminded everyone how the change in second program award points really does work to balance out the grades and sort the dogs appropriately.

During the second program high point, two LGRA dogs escaped their x-pens and immediately sought to join the fun, which, of course, is no fun at all. Good fortune was on our side as this very dangerous situation resulted in no injuries and no harm. The outcome – both desired and regretted – was that the high point Whippets had to rest and wait to re-run the race.

After 40 minutes of LGRA runs, the Whippets again took to the boxes. The rest seemed to be exactly what Gooey needed as she broke excellently from the three box beside Sullivan and tore down the track. Again, helping LGRA line judges were thrilled by the exciting finish that found Sullivan unable to take the lead from an inspired Gooey. Four solid contenders followed a fraction behind, crossing the paint in order of Aine, Validus, Jacob and Liam.

As the day before, 1:00p temperatures were reaching the mid-90s, though this day the cloud cover did more to insulate than isolate the sun shining down. Humidity was high and the ground separation had continued to open up beyond yesterday's spread. AAWC members Jessica and Matt spent a good bit of time pouring mulch from bags and breaking sod with shovels and shoes alike.

Concerns for safety reaching its height for the weekend, whippet entrants again voted to run just three programs this day. As we began the

third program, Gooey and Sullivan were tied for first place with the next nearing hound, Aine, a full 5.5 points behind. These two knew it was a second day of head-to-head. As the boxes opened, Gooey again found fast feet but Sullivan would not be left behind. The pack strode strong down the track and away from the box crew to indiscernible positions. Picking up judges' sheets, it was clear that Gooey held her place with panache while allowing Sullivan fair opportunity for work well done. Aine kept her place as well, following shortly behind in third for both the race and the day. Pleasure was had by all that saw, and now hopefully by those that did not as well.

Finding some difficulty narrowing a field of "really nice dogs, each and every one," this day Jack ultimately found weekend newcomer Jacob most favorable, followed by Aine, Sullivan and Liam.

Congratulations to all the winners, on the track and and in the ring alike. AAWC is very happy to have been able to host a meet after such a long and unwanted hiatus. We hope to see familiar and new faces again in the fall as we plan our future events.
