HOST HOTEL: Best Western Bakerview, 1821 Sumas Way, Abbotsford, <http://www.bestwesternbakerview.com> Rate is: \$99 for room with 2 Queens plus a microwave and fridge. Rooms need to be reserved by **July 22nd** to get that rate. Mention it is for the **RFF block** when making your reservations. This is an older hotel and NOT fancy –and not a lot of area to walk dogs but the hotel is clean and very dog friendly. 10 minutes from the race site. **Book early** – they will only hold 10 rooms until July 22nd as it is summer vacation time.

TRAVEL OPTIONS:

The closest airport is Abbotsford Airport, which is serviced by WestJet. Vancouver Airport is approximately 1 hour from the race site. Seattle, Washington is approximately a 2-hour drive. Avoid driving in Seattle rush hour – it's nasty! Allow plenty of time for border crossing, as it is very busy in the summer. We suggest the Lynden/Aldergrove or Sumas/Abbotsford border crossings to avoid the busiest crossings closer to Vancouver. !

ATTENTION USA EXHIBITORS:

A current Passport or Enhanced Driver's License or Nexus Pass, and valid Rabies certificate for each dog, is required for Canada/USA border crossings. Weapons are not permitted to be brought into Canada. We suggest you fill up with gasoline before crossing the border as gas prices are much cheaper in the US!

DIRECTIONS:

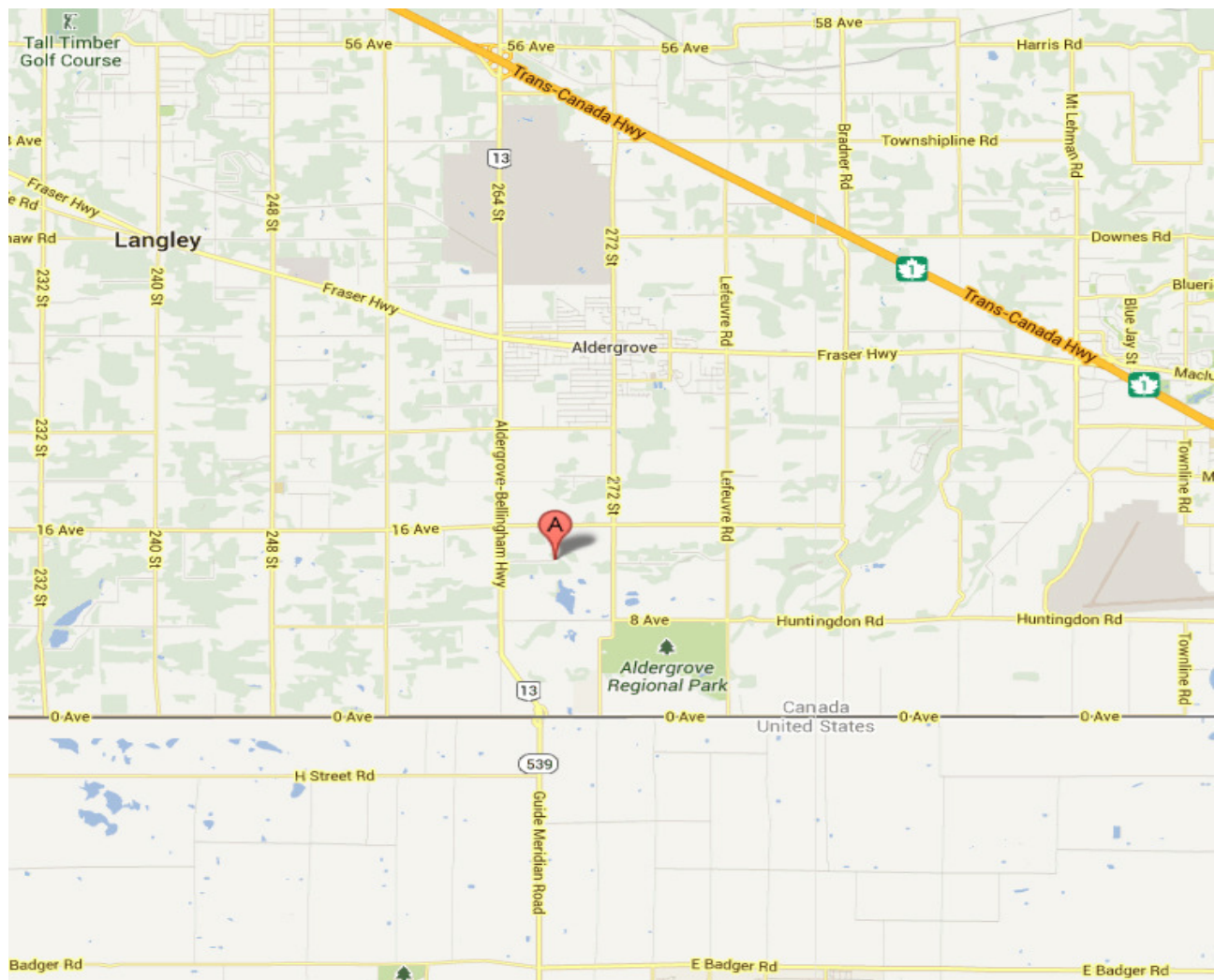
TO FRIDAY MATCH AND SATURDAY EVENING BBQ:

From the USA – take Interstate 5 north and exit in Bellingham at Exit 256 (SR-539/Guide Meridian St/Sumas/Lynden). Turn right at the light at bottom of ramp and proceed north on Guide Meridian (SR539). You can grocery shop and fill up with gasoline in Lynden, about 12 miles north. The US/Canada border crossing is approximately 3 miles north of Lynden – just stay on Guide Meridian (SR539) and it takes you straight to the border. Once you cross the border, turn right onto 13th Avenue (the third street after the border). Follow to end of road, last house on the left. Park on road or enter farm gate at the end of property if you require shade

From Vancouver area: take the 264th Street (Rte 13) exit from Highway 1 and go south approximately 5 miles. Turn left onto 13th Avenue and follow to end of road.

From hotels to the east -: get onto Highway 1 and go west, take the 264th Street (Rte 13) exit from Highway 1 and go south approximately 5 miles. Turn left onto 13th Avenue and follow to end of road.

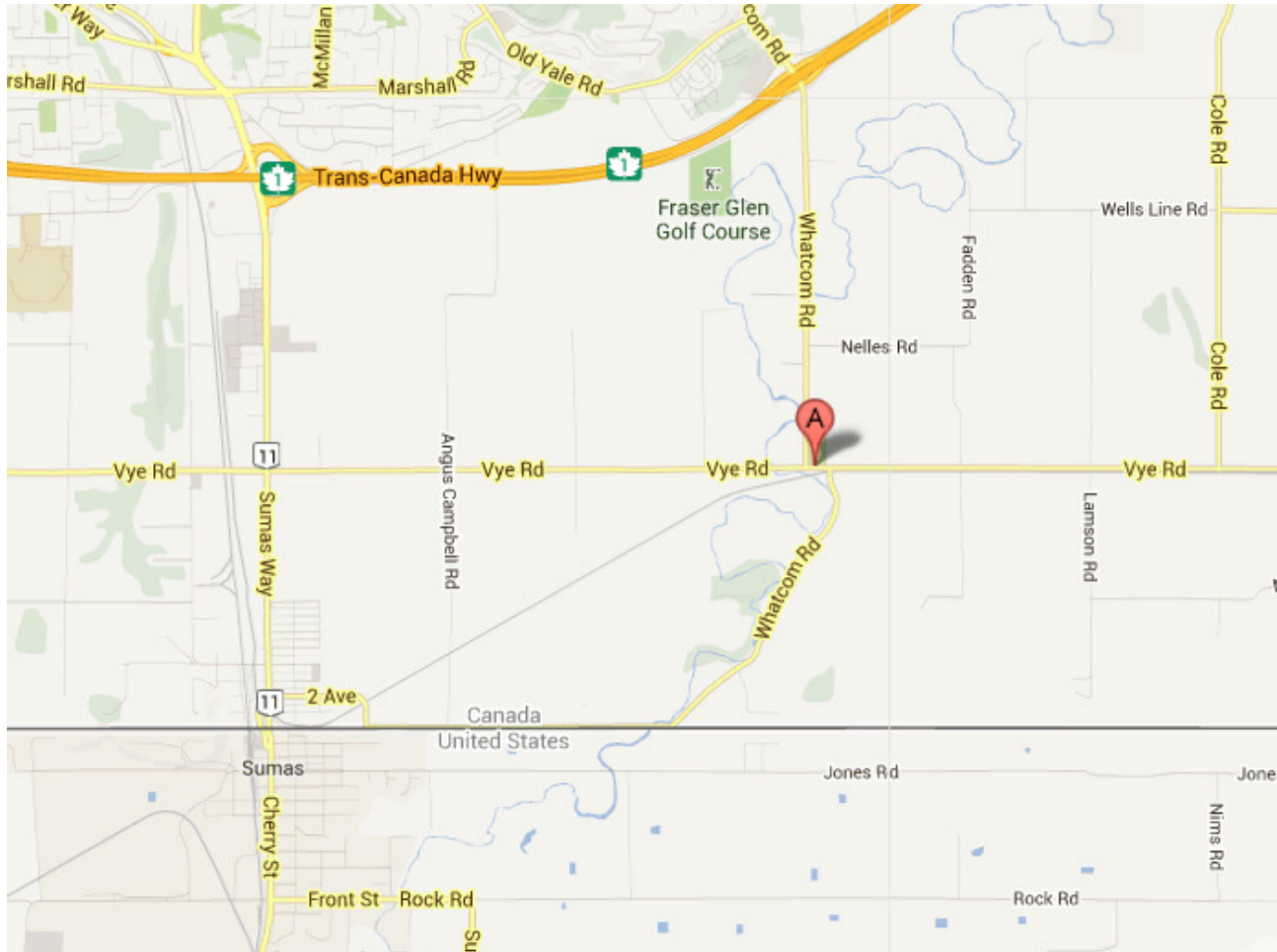

DIRECTIONS

One Day Farms - Field is located on Sawdust Rd, Hull GA 30646

From I-85 Southbound and Northbound take exit 149 (Commerce exit). At the end of the ramp turn left if coming southbound and right if coming northbound onto Route 441-15 South. Follow Route 441 South for approx 5 ½ miles. Look for railroad crossing signs. When you see the railroad crossing signs, get into the left lane. At the light, turn left onto Route 334 East (landmark = Ingles grocery store). Follow Route 334 East for approx 6 miles. You will pass a small farm equipment store (Vermeer Equipment) on the left. Approximately ¾ mile past this store, turn left on Seagraves Mill Road. Follow Seagraves Mill Road for 3 ½ miles to the stop sign (crossroad is Nowhere Road/Sawdust Rd). Take Sawdust Rd. 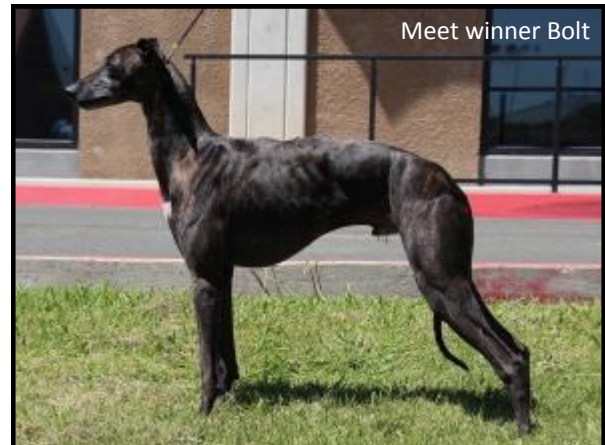

I must mention that one of the factors that helped us get our meet done so fast was having David Kay do our lure-return on his ATV. He was a great help and for that I say, "Thank you David."

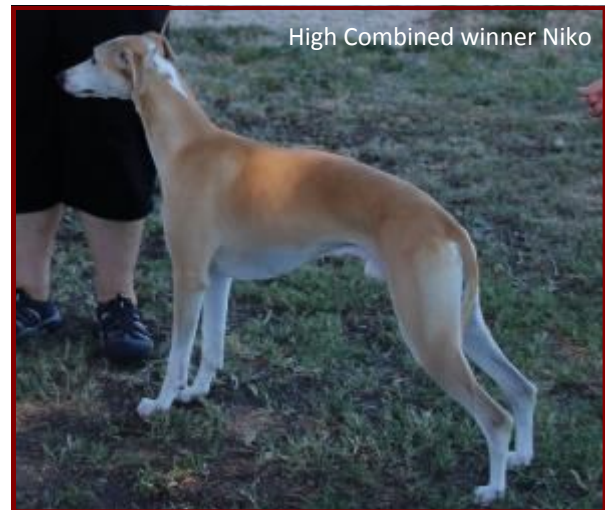
I must also thank everyone who helped on this miserable hot day to make it a successful day of racing. You were all greatly appreciated.
