he weather forecast was grim. Temperatures would be in the high nineties with heat index over 100. Last race meet it was pouring rain, so this time it's hot hot. On Friday night Ule made chocolate chip cookies out of the oven for those who came by.

On Saturday we had 18 whippets to start and 10 LGRA dogs. We changed the start time to 8 am to try to avoid some of the predicted heat. We really appreciate folks coming back from the national and then coming to our meet — what troopers!

The first program resulted in the following results, Moto won the D race, Reba won the C race, Loon won the B race and the A race finish was Kazi, Lizzie, Rafa, Ziggy and Goldie. Unfortunately Bose had to be scratched due to a pad injury.

In the second program Benjamin won the first race, Ziggy won the second race, and the high point finish was Kazi, Lizzie, Rafa, Loon, Reba and Moto. In that race, the dogs had to do a U-turn as the line snapped and the lure stopped. The pictures below of the dogs trying to react to the lure stopping and disappearing behind them are very neat. Took a while for the dogs to do a U-turn and get back to the lure.











The third program had Goldie winning the first race, and the high point finish was Kazi, Lizzie, Ziggy, Loon, Reba and Moto.

In the first race of Program 4, Benjamin, Moto, Fanta, Annie, Fling and Cash were greeted by an expanding bag as they raced down the field. The bag got bigger and bigger and bigger and bigger and finally stalled out like a hot air balloon. Then it looks like the bag is a whippet eating bag.

The fourth program saw Benjamin winning the first race, and the high point finish was Lizzie, Kazi, Ziggy, Goldie, Loon and Reba.

The final finish was Kazi, Lizzie, Ziggy, Goldie and Loon. Kazi got 3 NARX and Lizzie 1 NARX points. No ARX points were awarded due to the 50% rule. Kazi injured a pad so could not come back on Sunday.

For conformation, Mary George from Peoria, Illinois, found the following dogs to her liking: Cash, Reba, Benjamin and Fling.

This resulted in Cash being the High Combined whippet for the day (by adding the conformation points on to the race meet points and the high combined was awarded to the whippet with the highest points who had won a placement in conformation).

The LGRA meet consisted of basenjis and cirneci. The basenji finish was Ari, Tempest, Bisa, Gambit and Xander. For the cirneci it was Fidget, Biz-E, Calista, Kiki and Mouse. One of the Stewarts' basenjis finished its SGRC.

We retired to the air conditioning in the house and chicken, sweet corn and a variety











of pot luck dishes. The wrapped gifts were done on Saturday. The stylish muzzle was very popular and was stolen until it reached the maximum number of steals possible and ended up with Deb Borton. The beer was stolen a time or two. When Carl picked he picked a box with a lovely pink and lime green fish man purse. Next time you see him ask him to show you his new purse; he is very proud of it. Then everyone went to wherever they were staying with air conditioning.



On Sunday, we decided to start measuring at 7 am to avoid the heat. Unfortunately, the fog was so dense that we couldn't start until the fog cleared. For the first few races we used a flashlight at the box as just the first 10 or 20 yads were dim. The temperature was not bad with the overcast skies blocking the sun. We finished in time to just have the sun come out at 11:30 am. There were only 13 brave Whippets competing and 8 LGRA dogs.

For CWA, the Ginny won the D race, Fling won the C race, the Loon won the B race, and Lizzie won the A race. In the second program Benjamin won the first race and the hi-point finish was Lizzie, Ziggy, Goldie, Loon, Fling and Ginny. In the third program

Goldie won the first race and the high point was Lizzie, Rafa, Ziggy, Loon, Fling and Ginny. In the final program, Cash won the first race and the high point finishwas Ziggy, Lizzie, Goldie, Benjamin, Loon and Fling. Unfortunately, once again, the 50% rule meant no ARX points were awarded. Lizzie won 3 NARX points and Ziggy won 1 NARX point.

In conformation, Pam Thornburg found Cash, Reba, Ziggy and Benjamin to her liking. This meant Ziggy was the high combined for the day. Three of the four dogs were the same as Saturday.

The LGRA meet consisted of basenjis, rhodesians and cirneci. The basenji finish was Ari and Bisa; the cirneci finish was Fidget, Biz-E, Kiki and Mouse; and the rhodesian finish was Sassy and Randa.

We retired inside to have ham and buns and some delightful leftovers. Unfortunately, there was an exploding watermelon; when cut into it was like a volcano spewing into the air.

Thanks so much to everyone who pitched in and helped with cooking, getting prizes, picture taking, line and foul judging, taking down dogs, etc. It moved pretty efficiently with the number of people on hand. There are definite advantages to having both LGRA and CWA as each group's people can help out the others. Thanks to all the participants who stuck out the heat and all the traveling.
