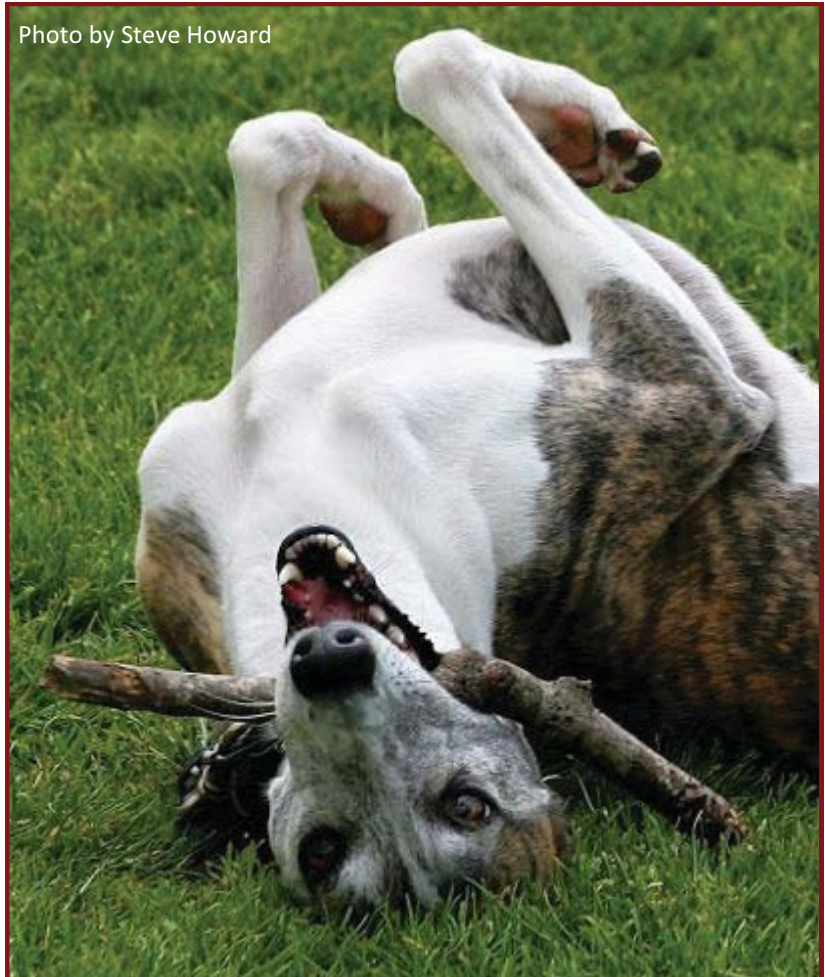
Max had another stellar performance on the track winning all four programs to win the
