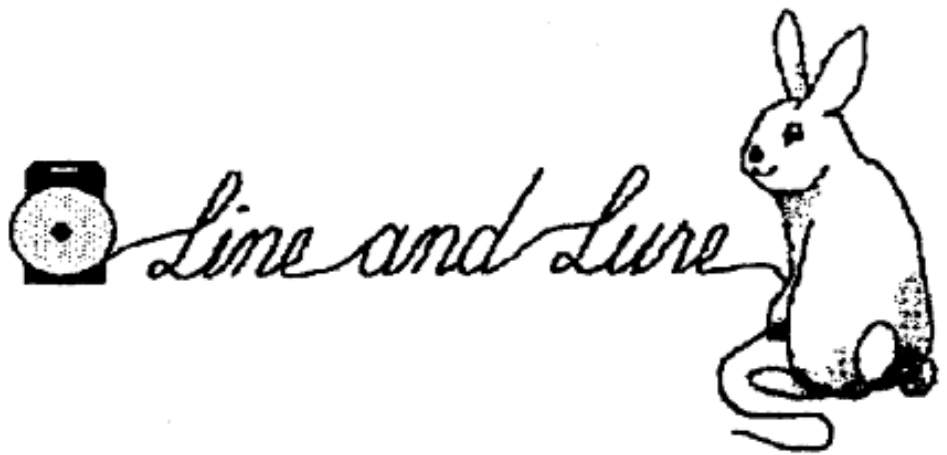

### *From the East:*

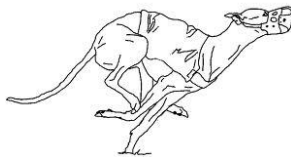

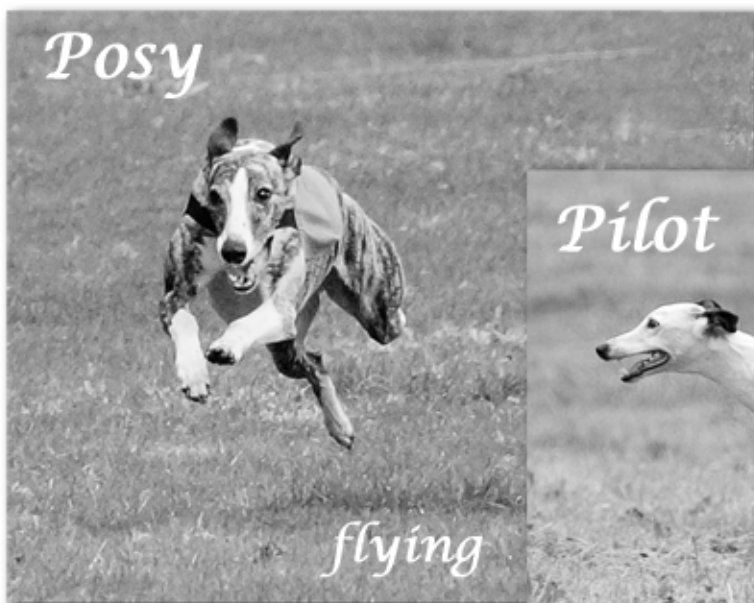
