Bring water for your hounds, and shade if unseasonable hot weather is expected (rare in PA in April). The parking area is not shaded. **THIS IS A NEW SITE AND WE WANT TO MAKE A GREAT IMPRESSION.** Please help us to keep it clean and tidy and leave it as we found it!

Directions:

FROM I-95: If coming from the South on I-95, Take Exit 100—272. Take 272 North to just before you get to US1. Across from the Super WaWa, there is a sign to Nottingham County Park. Follow signs to Nottingham County Park, pass the main entrance to Nottingham County Park on your left. Go 0.7 miles to the gate on the left—there will be a sign. You should be able to see the equestrian ring on your left as you approach the gate to the special equestrian activities area.

If coming from the north on I-95, take Rt. 322 N (Westchester) to Rt. 1. Take Rt. 1 to Rt. 272 (Nottingham). Go south on 272, turn right at the WaWa, and then follow signs to Nottingham County Park as given above.

FROM the PA Turnpike: If coming from the west on the PA Turnpike, take Take exit number 247 to I-283E. Take 283E to Rt. 72 South. Take Rt. 72 S to 272 S (it basically becomes 272 South, and then take 272 all the way until you cross over US 1 and see the WaWa on your left. Turn right at the WaWa and then proceed as described for the directions from I-95.

If coming from the East on the PA Turnpike, exit at 476, and take 476 to Rt. 1, and proceed to the Rt. 272 Nottingham exit, go south, turn right at the Super WaWa, then to the field as given for directions from I-95
